The **Environmental Determinants of Islet Autoimmunity (ENDIA)** study is finding out what causes type 1 diabetes.

In Australia, type 1 diabetes in children is twice as common as it was 20 years ago.

If we understand how environmental factors and exposures may contribute to or protect against type 1 diabetes, we will be better equipped to develop strategies that may prevent type 1 diabetes in the future.
