ENDIA environmental determinants of islet autoimmunity

The Environmental Determinants of Islet Autoimmunity (ENDIA) study is finding out what causes type I diabetes.

In Australia, type I diabetes in children is twice as common as it was 20 years ago.

If we understand how environmental factors and exposures may contribute to or protect against type I diabetes, we will be better equipped to develop strategies that may prevent type I diabetes in the future.
